INTRODUCTION

- Climate actions for the sector guided by the KCSAS, KCSAIF and newly developed *Agriculture Long Term Strategy* (LTS)
- The MSP provides an inclusive institutional framework for **coordination and harmonization** of CSA implementation while fostering an **enabling environment** for the realization of CSA objectives
- Facilitate partnerships among state and non-state actors at both National and County levels in areas of CSA;
 - research-extension-farmer liaison and funding,
 - policy prioritization and advocacy,
 - programmatic planning and implementation,
 - institutional capacities development as well as data collection,
 - information management and dissemination.

WHY COUNTY MSPs

- The sector is obliged to implement climate change actions consistent with national goal of **low carbon resilient development**.
- The coordination mechanism started at national level needs to be replicated at the county level where implementation of most of the CSA activities take place.
- This will foster an enabling environment, enhance synergy in CSA implementation between the private and public sector partners for wide-scale adoption of climate smart agriculture (CSA) practices.
- This will also provide the coordination mechanism for monitoring, evaluation and reporting on climate adaptation and mitigation as provided by the Climate Change Act.
